How to Use

What Is Hymn Study?

Hymn study is a wonderful way to teach your children the great hymns of the faith. Based on the principles Charlotte Mason used to teach poetry and folk songs, hymn study gently introduces lyrics and music in a memorable, meaningful way.

It's simple to incorporate hymn study into your home school. Just select one hymn to sing together until everyone has learned each stanza. That's all there is to it!

If you want to go deeper, you can look up and read the story behind the hymn and its writer. You might also have your children use a hymn's lyrics for copywork, dictation, or recitation.

How This Book Works

We've selected 72 great hymns to use for hymn study. These hymns are arranged into twelve groups with six hymns in each group. We recommend you learn one hymn group each school year. We've tried to include hymns for various holidays. Feel free to use the hymns in any order.

To help you learn each hymn, a simple instrumental arrangement has been included as an electronic download. If you're unfamiliar with the tune, or just want an accompaniment for singing, you can listen to the included music. You'll also find sheet music for each hymn if you or your children would like to play it on your own instrument.

Additional Notes

- In case you are unfamiliar with hymns, here's a quick explanation of how a hymn should be sung: The numbered stanzas are sung in sequence. If the hymn includes a refrain, it should be sung between stanzas. To help you with the sequence, we've included a note (*Refrain*) to show you when to sing the refrain.
- As you learn these hymns, you will likely come across unfamiliar words, or you may see familiar words used in unusual ways. Take the time to look up difficult words and discern the meanings.
- You may also notice that words here and there in the stanzas have changed over the years. If you know a different version, feel free to substitute the words with which you are most familiar.
- Just as the beautiful words of poetry should be read in a beautiful way, so the lyrics of hymns should be sung in a meaningful way. Try to fit the pace you sing to the feeling behind the words, and be expressive. Think about what the hymn is saying. Is it a prayer? A joyful proclamation? A call to worship? How would you sing it in light of its meaning?
- Many of these hymns have quite a few stanzas, some of which may be difficult to sing. We've chosen to include all the stanzas we could find; for certain hymns, recommended stanzas have been marked in bold. This doesn't mean you are required to use only the marked stanzas. We encourage you to choose the ones you want to use. You may even want to include your children in deciding which stanzas your family wants to sing.
- We've included the tune names for each hymn. This is because many hymns use the same tunes. If you study more hymns in the future, you will discover that it's not uncommon to find hymns set to tunes you already know. This means you can learn a new hymn with less effort.
